

REGION VII BYLAWS IDAHO SCHOOL BOARDS ASSOCIATION

ARTICLE I - NAME AND PURPOSE

- 1. **Name:** The name of this association shall be IDAHO SCHOOL BOARDS ASSOCIATION REGION VII.
- 2. **Purpose:** The purposes of the Region shall be similar to the purposes as provided by the bylaws of the IDAHO SCHOOL BOARDS ASSOCIATION and shall specifically include the following:
 - a. To promote the general advancement of education.
 - b. To promote and maintain local control of the State's public schools.
 - c. To conduct meetings of the trustees and superintendents in the region to discuss legislative resolutions, proposals and other items of mutual interest.
 - d. To study, interpret, propose and influence legislation that may effect education.
 - e. To collect pertinent data and information and disseminate through appropriate publications.
 - f. To promote training and orientation on a regional basis for school board members.
- 3. Nothing in these bylaws may be in conflict with the ISBA Bylaws, state or federal laws or any higher authority. Should such an event arise, this higher authority takes precedence over the lower and said item shall be null and void.

ARTICLE II - MEMBERSHIP, DUES, FISCAL YEAR

- 1. **Membership:** Membership shall be limited to those trustee districts who are members of the Idaho School Boards Association and who pay regional dues approved by the membership.
 - a. School districts in the following counties are eligible for membership in Region VII: Lemhi, Custer, and Butte.

- 2. **Dues:** Each district's dues for the regional association shall consist of such amounts as established by the membership in its annual meeting. Dues are payable at the beginning of the fiscal year.
- 3. **Fiscal Year:** The fiscal year shall be the same as that of the Idaho School Boards Association—July 1 June 30.

ARTICLE III - MEETINGS

The annual meeting of the region members shall be held on a date as determined by the officers. Any meetings of trustees and superintendents shall be held as determined by the Executive Committee.

ARTICLE IV – OFFICERS

1. **Officers:** The officers of the Regional Association shall be Chair, Vice Chair, and Secretary/Treasurer, and alternate. The Vice Chair shall automatically succeed to the office of the Chair. The Secretary/Treasurer shall be the Superintendent of the district in which the Chair serves as trustee.

- a. The past President shall serve as an ex-officio officer.
- b. Elections shall be held in odd-numbered years at annual state convention with one vote per trustee present, simple majority determining the winner.
- c. The Chair shall appoint an alternate to serve in the absence of either the Chair or Vice Chair at any Regional or ISBA Executive Board Meetings.

2. Term of Office: The officers shall take office with the installation of executive officers at the ISBA Annual Meeting and shall serve for a term of two years or until their successors are elected or qualified. The Vice Chair will automatically become the Regional Chair following their term as Vice Chair. Officers shall assume office with the installation of executive officers at the ISBA Annual Convention of year elected.

2. **Vacancies:** Regional members shall elect at a regional meeting of trustees, a member to fill the unexpired term of any office for which a vacancy occurs.
