

Teacher Evaluation Standards

Question:

Does a school district have any standards they are required to follow regarding the evaluation of certificated teaching personnel?

Answer:

In addition to the statutory guidelines that identify the number of evaluations and specific components of parental input and objective measures of student growth that will be required to be included in next year's evaluations, (Idaho Code 33-514(4) and 33-515(2)) the Idaho Administrative Procedures Act, specifically 08.02.02.120, contains provisions associated with requirements for each local school district's policies for teacher performance and evaluation. This is the provision of Idaho law that requires school districts to utilize an evaluation tool based upon the Danielson Framework for Teaching Second Edition domains and components of instruction. The process relating to the adoption of criteria and procedures for the evaluation of certificated personnel is to allow opportunity for input from those affected, i.e. trustees, administrators, and teachers.
