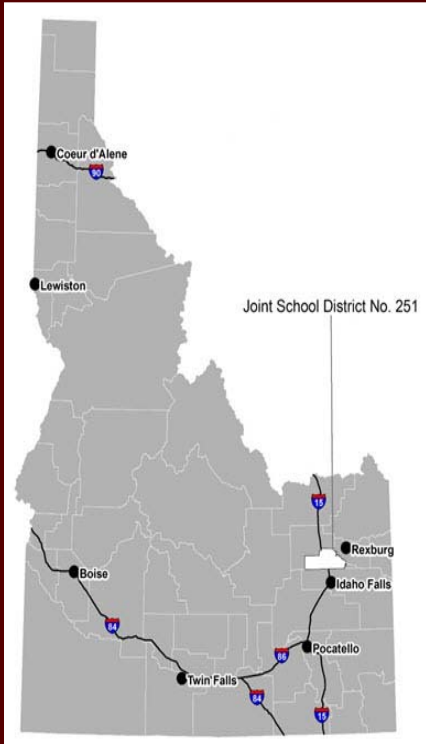

District Profile

Jefferson Joint School District 251 is the eleventh largest school district in the state of Idaho. The district is made up of 1 preschool center, 6 elementary schools, 1 middle school, 2 high schools and 1 online high school. Over the past 20 years the district has grown by 53%, with an average of 3.6% annually. The current average enrollment is 6,167 students in grades p-12. The district employs 328 certified staff and 330 non-certified staff.

The budget for the district is \$44 million (includes general and federal funds), and \$36 million bond funding for a new elementary school and other bond projects.
