








OUR VISION

Middleton School District takes in the beautiful farm country of north Canyon County. With a small town feel, population just over 5,600, Middleton is main street U.S.A. Groceries and general needs are available in town with major shopping outlets 15 minutes away in Nampa, everything you need is available without any of the congestion of the big city. If you start to yearn for city life, Boise is less than 30 minutes away providing all of the cultural and sports events a person could want. Middleton is an outdoor paradise with the Boise River running through town providing swimming, rafting, fishing and hunting at every turn. THE DISTRICT

Comprised of six schools, the Middleton School District serves nearly 4,200 students. Our District has 232 highly qualified teaching staff and a School Board that supports collaborative structures that maximize student achievement.

- A strong instructional leader with effective communication skills, budgetary experience, and passion for students.
- Shows respect, transparency, good judgment, and integrity in relationships with trustees, administrators, teachers, parents, students, and community.
- Ready and able to chart the course for the next exciting chapter of our district by taking a creative and innovative approach to education by minimizing budgetary constraints and maximizing educational opportunities.
- Be of good character, with high morals and unquestionable integrity, meeting the standards of the community and patrons being served.
