

# BOARD MEMBER AWARD OF LEADERSHIP

## ISBA LEADERSHIP AWARDS PROGRAM

The Idaho School Boards Association recognizes the time and effort that School Board members devote to Idaho's public education. These public servants direct expenditures, oversee the work, and set the high standards necessary to prepare students for life in the 21st century. ISBA is pleased to announce a recognition program that will honor both individual school board members' and entire boards' commitment to public education and School Board leadership.

### How Does the Leadership Awards Program Work?

School Board members earn points by participating in the three categories of activities. There are three levels of awards. For each level; Gold, Silver, and Bronze; points in each activity category are added together.

#### We describe the three categories as:

- ◆ ACT
- ◆ LEARN
- ◆ LEAD



#### ◆ ACT:

This category is based on attending events. Points are earned by School Board members attending events at ISBA, NSBA, or the Ed Law Conference.

#### ◆ LEARN:

This category is centered on in-district/charter professional development workshops. Points are earned by having someone from our Professional Development Department come and present a workshop or a Town Hall.

#### ◆ LEAD:

This category is focused on leadership. Points are awarded based on the involvement of School Board members in leadership roles. Examples include serving in a leadership position on their local board or on the ISBA Executive Board, writing an article for our SLATE magazine, or presenting at ISBA events.

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## SCORING:

Points are earned during a 12 month period: from July 1 through June 30.  
The breakdown of each level is as follows:



**Gold Level: 325 points**



**Silver Level: 250 points**



**Bronze Level: 125 points**

◆ **If the majority of the Board receives an award, the entire school district or charter will receive a Master of Leadership Award.**
