School: One building provides the education for 74 elementary students (grades PreK-5), 36 middle school students (grades 6-8), and 54 high school students (grades 9-12). The school also provides half-day preschool classes for students who have been identified as special needs and other children in the community. Additionally, our school district has a four-day school week and is proud of our small teacher-to-student class ratios.
