


# OURVISION

# **DISTRICT HIGHLIGHTS**



- Our District ISAT results surpass the state average in English/Literacy by 11 percentage points, Mathematics by 18 percentage points, and Science by 6 percentage points.
- We have experienced teachers. Within our district, 68% of teachers have over 5 years Idaho teaching experience, and we have a teacher retention rate over 80%.
- Our district's 5 year graduation rate is 91.7%. In the 2019-2020 year 98.7% of students graduated.
- The average GPA at Marsh Valley High School in 2019-2020 was 3.01 (9-12 grades). The average for 12th grade students was 3.33
- We prepare students for the future, 93% of high school students participate in college and career readiness courses.



- We are proud of our athletes' academic achievements. In 2019-2020 the Marsh Valley High School Boys Basketball Team was awarded the Boys Basketball Academic 3A State Champions award.
