- **2019-20:** 2550 students
- **2020-21:** 7200 students



Southeastern Idaho Technical Charter School (SEITEC)

The **SEITEC** is a professional/technical charter school formed by the cooperative efforts of three rural school districts (Oneida School District, Preston School District, and West Side School District) who recognize the need for high-end professional/technical programs as well as the challenge of funding quality programs. It is made up of professional/technical students and teachers from the participating school district's high schools and is overseen by a Board of Trustees and an administrator whose primary focus is the success of SEITEC students and programs.

- Experience or knowledge about virtual or online schooling.
