

THE COMMUNITY

Buhl is located in the Magic Valley of South-Central Idaho. The Snake River flows through the Magic Valley and offers access to quality fishing and recreational activities. Buhl is a rural community with strong ties to agriculture. Several farmers markets are available offering access to fresh produce during the spring and summer.

The Clear Lakes Country Club in Buhl has a beautiful 18 hole golf course open to the public. Areas for camping, biking, and hiking are nearby whether you like mountains, rivers, lakes, or the desert.

Four ski resorts (including Sun Valley) are within a two-hour drive, Jackpot, Nevada (sometimes referred to as a mini-Las Vegas) is one hour south, and Boise is two hours northwest.

Twin Falls, (population 50,000) is a 20-minute drive and has a wide variety of shopping available including Costco and the Magic Valley Mall. The College of Southern Idaho is also located in Twin Falls and offers many opportunities for the surrounding communities.

The community of Buhl (population 4,200) is in the midst of a modest growth in its economic base. There are over 240 businesses located in the Buhl area.

- Show respect, transparency, good judgment, and integrity in relationships with trustees, administrators, teachers, parents, students, and community.
- Be of good character, with high morals and unquestionable integrity, meeting the standards of the community and patrons being served.
- Experience or knowledge about virtual or online schooling.

For the selected candidate, the Board will offer a comprehensive benefits package and a salary range of \$90,000 - \$115,000 dependent upon experience.
