Garden Valley is a small, rural school district in Idaho located in a scenic valley about an hour from downtown Boise. Garden Valley School enjoys a newly constructed building serving roughly 316 PK-12 students for a four-day (plus) schedule. We are also fortunate to have a resource officer, school nurse, and extra-curricular clubs and activities that include Drum Core, Future Cities, various athletics, Middle School Activities, etc. and offer numerous dual credit and AP course offerings to our students. The District also includes a historic one-room mixed grade school house located in Lowman serving students K-5. We have an extremely supportive community! Payette Forward and Garden Valley Center for the Arts both partner with the school in various ways and support our programs and community.


OUR VISION
