- 6. Use instructional materials adopted by the district and employ methods that are most appropriate for meeting stated objectives. Follow effective schooling practice.
- 7. Evaluate student progress on a regular basis and provide progress reports as required.
- 8. Take all necessary and reasonable precautions to protect students, equipment, materials and facilities. Follow prescribed safety regulations.
- 9. Maintain accurate, complete and correct records and reports as required by law, district policy, and administrative regulations and requests.
- 10. Accept responsibility for extra-curricular activities and other duties as may be assigned to meet the needs of students.
- 11. Work to establish and maintain open lines of communications and cooperative relations with the administration, students, parents and colleagues.
- 12. Attend staff meetings and serve on staff committees to plan instructional goals, objectives and methods; assist in selection of instructional equipment and materials.
- 13. Strive to maintain and improve professional competence.
- 14. Perform such other duties as may be related to this position.
