

REGION I BYLAWS

IDAHO SCHOOL BOARDS ASSOCIATION

ARTICLE I – NAME AND PURPOSE

1. **Name:** The name of this association shall be IDAHO SCHOOL BOARDS ASSOCIATION (ISBA) REGION I.

2. **Purpose:** The purposes of the region shall be similar to the purposes as provided by the bylaws of the ISBA and shall:

- a. Promote the general advancement of education;
- b. Promote and maintain local governance of the State's public schools;
- c. Conduct meetings of the trustees in the region to discuss legislative resolutions, proposals, and other items of mutual interest;
- d. Study, interpret, propose, and influence legislation that may affect education;
- e. Collect pertinent data and information and disseminate through appropriate publications; and
- f. Promote training and orientation on a regional basis for school Board members.

3. **Authority:** Nothing in these bylaws may be in conflict with the ISBA Bylaws, state or federal laws, or any higher authority. Should such an event arise, this higher authority takes precedence over the lower and said item shall be null and void.

ARTICLE II – MEMBERSHIP AND FISCAL YEAR

1. **Member Districts:** The districts eligible for membership in Region I are Avery #394, Boundary County #101, Coeur d'Alene #271, Kellogg #391, Kootenai #274, Lakeland #272, Lake Pend Oreille #084, Mullan #392, Plummer Worley #044, Post Falls #273, St. Maries #041, Wallace #393, and West Bonner County #083.

2. **Membership:** Membership shall be limited to those districts in Region I and that have paid their dues to ISBA.

3. **Membership Large/Small Districts:** The membership of Region I district trustees shall be divided into large and small districts.

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- 49 **4. Determination of Large/Small Districts:** Determination of large and small
50 districts shall be made at the annual meeting in November on the basis of the most
51 current enrollments attained from the State Department of Education, Large
52 districts shall include fifty percent (50%) of the member districts with the greatest
53 number of students enrolled. Small districts shall include the remaining districts in
54 the region. If there are an odd number of member districts, the median district
55 shall be included as a small district.

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- 59 **5. Fiscal Year:** The fiscal year shall be the same as that of ISBA – July 1 – June 30.

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63 ARTICLE III – MEETINGS 64

- 65 **1. Annual Meeting:** The annual meeting of the Region I Association shall be held
66 on a date determined by the Officers. If no determination is made it shall be held
67 at the ISBA Annual Convention.

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- 71 **2. Region Meeting:** Region meetings shall be held at least once annually. Region
72 meetings shall be held at a school district located within the region and that is
73 centrally located for all of the districts in that region.

78 of three (3) member districts. Special meetings may be conducted electronically
79 or as agreed upon by the Executive Committee.

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83 ARTICLE IV – OFFICERS AND ELECTIONS 84

85 **1. Officers:** 86

- 87 **a.** The officers of Region I shall be Chair, Vice Chair, Large District Alternate, and
88 Small District Alternate. The Chair shall designate one Alternate to be the
89 Secretary and one Alternate to be the Treasurer if needed.
90 **b.** The Chair and Vice Chair shall represent both a large and small district. These
91 offices shall alternate at each election.

- 92 c. The Executive Committee shall consist of the Chair, Vice Chair, Large District
93 Alternate, and Small District Alternate.

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98 **2. Elections:**
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- 100 a. Elections for Region I shall be held at the Annual Meeting in odd-numbered
101 years.
102 b. The offices of the Region I Chair and Vice Chair shall alternate between large
103 and small districts.
104 c. The Chair shall call for nominations from the floor for Vice Chair.
105 d. The election of officers shall be by written ballot, one vote per member present
106 at the meeting. The same procedure will be used for the Large District Alternate
107 and the Small District Alternate.
108 e. The Vice Chair automatically ascends to the office of Chair and, therefore, does
109 not run for election.

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116 **3. Terms of Office:**
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- 118 a. The term of each office is for two (2) years.
119 b. The officers shall take office with the installation of the Executive Officers at the
120 Annual Convention.

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124 **4. Vacancies:**
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- 126 a. In case of a vacancy in the office of the Chair, the Vice Chair shall ascend to
127 the office of the Chair.
128 b. The Chair shall appoint either the current Large or Small District Alternate to fill
129 the Vice Chair vacancy. The Chair will assure that both large and small districts
130 are represented in the Chair and Vice Chair positions.
131 c. The Chair shall appoint either a Large or Small District Alternate dependent
132 upon who has been appointed to become the Vice Chair.
133 d. In case of a vacancy of both the Chair and Vice Chair, the Large and Small
134 District Alternates shall replace the vacated positions.
135 e. Any new officer that has been appointed or takes over a vacant position and
136 has not been elected by the membership will hold office until the next Annual

Meeting. At that time, new officers will be elected according to the procedures outlined in these bylaws.

- 5. Removal of an Officer:** If an officer fails to attend three (3) consecutive meetings, the officer may be discharged from the office by a sixty percent (60%) vote of the Executive Committee. An officer may also be removed from office if the proposed removal is distributed to the membership at least ten (10) days prior to a duly convened meeting and the vote for removal is adopted by sixty-six percent (66%) of the members present at the meeting.

6. Duties of the Chair:

- a. Regularly attend ISBA Executive Board meetings to represent the membership of Region I;
- b. Fulfill the individual goals the Chair establishes each year as part of the ISBA Strategic Plan;
- c. Serve on committees for the ISBA Executive Board;
- d. Regularly schedule, conduct, and attend Region I meetings;
- e. Appoint Special Committee members as needed;
- f. Communicate with the membership of Region I on important issues;
- g. Promote open communication and actively work to engage region trustee participation in the region and region meetings;
- h. Promote region participation in all the services ISBA offers; and
- i. Model ethical behavior.

7. Duties of the Vice Chair:

- a. Fulfill all Chair functions when the Chair is unable to do so;
- b. Regularly attend ISBA Executive Board meetings to represent the membership of Region I;
- c. Fulfill the individual goals the Vice Chair establishes each year as part of the ISBA Strategic Plan;
- d. Serve on committees for the ISBA Executive Board;
- e. Regularly attend Region I meetings;
- f. When asked by the Chair, communicate with the membership of Region I on important issues;
- g. Promote open communication and actively work to engage region trustee participation in the region and region meetings;
- h. Promote region participation in all the services ISBA offers;

- i. Model ethical behavior; and
- j. Assume the position of Chair after the two (2) year term or when the Chair position becomes vacant.

8. Duties of the Large or Small District Alternate:

- a. Attend ISBA Executive Board meetings when the comparable size district officer is unable to attend;
- b. Serve on committees for the ISBA Executive Board;
- c. Regularly attend Region I meetings;
- d. When asked by the Chair, communicate with the membership of Region I on important issues;
- e. Promote open communication and actively work to engage region trustee participation in the region and region meetings;
- f. Promote region participation in all the services ISBA offers; and
- g. Model ethical behavior.

ARTICLE V – AMENDING REGION I BYLAWS

- 1. These bylaws may be amended, or new bylaws adopted, by simple majority vote of members present at any duly called regular or special ~~district~~ meeting of the Region I Association.

- 2. Proposals for bylaw changes may be made by the Executive Committee or any duly elected or appointed trustee of Region I holding membership with ISBA.

- 3. Proposed amendments shall be delivered, via electronic email, to the membership ten (10) days prior to a duly convened meeting at which the amendments are to be discussed.

5. Adopted amendments will be delivered to the membership within ninety (90) days following the duly convened meeting at which they were approved.
